The entrance to The Westbourne Centre is opposite Audley St George's Place retirement village.

By Train

The closest railway station is Five Ways which is located less than a mile away and just a 15 minute walk.

Birmingham's main railway stations, New Street, Snow Hill and Moor Street, are situated in the city centre and are all around 1.5 miles from The Westbourne Centre. Taxi ranks are located just outside the main stations.

By Bus

There are a number of buses that pass near to The Westbourne Centre.

Harborne services: 23, 24

Hagley Road services: 9, 120, 126, 127, 128, 140, 141

Parking

The Westbourne Centre has a small private car park which is free of charge.

Alternatively, many of the roads nearby – Calthorpe Road, Westbourne Road and Highfield Road, **allow 2 hours of free parking (subject to restrictions)**. There is also a pay and display car park behind the Highfield pub on Highfield Road.

Disabled Access

The Westbourne Centre has disabled entrances on both sides of the building.
